CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE - REACH

REGULATION (EU) No 1907/2006 + ECHA candidate list

UNIMED hereby certifies that according to its knowledge no material or finished product delivered by UNIMED to its customers contains any of the substances of very high concern (SVHC) according to the candidate list maintained by the European Chemicals Agency ECHA.

- Cobalt Cobalt is classified as carcinogenic category 1B and toxic for reproduction category 1B according to European REACH regulation (1907/2006).
Austenitic stainless steels contain traces of cobalt of maximum 0.1% in their composition. These traces from the extraction and refining of ores are difficult to eliminate.
The European regulation on medical devices MDR (2017/745) authorizes up to a maximum of 0.1% of category 1B carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic for reproduction substances.
In conclusion, the cobalt level complies with European regulations.

UNIMED therefore declares that its products comply with the above regulation.
